

Aurora Smart Lamp User guide

This guide tells you everything you need to know to use your Aurora Smart Lamp.

Your Aurora Smart Lamp can be turned on and off and dimmed remotely from your smartphone or tablet.

For AU-GSXB278/27 you can set schedules for when it turns on and off.

For AU-GSCXZB279 you can choose tones from cool to warm white and set schedules for when it turns on and off.

For AU-GSCLZB279 you can choose white or colour light and set schedules for when it turns on and off.

Max. radiated power: 10dBm
Frequency: 2400~2483.5MHz

Getting started:

① Add your Aurora Smart Lamp

You can do this using your Aurora app.

Using the Aurora app:

- Open the Aurora app on your smartphone or tablet.
- Create an account and log-in.
- On initial start-up the App will display a set of instructions on how to pair your lamp to the Hub. Subsequently add the lamp by selecting the Account tab followed by the “Add More Devices” option.

② Fit the Lamp into the Lamp fitting and switch the Lamp on

Ensure the wall switch for the Lamp is switched off before fitting the Lamp.

Your Aurora Smart Lamp is fitted in the same way traditional household Lamps are. Once fitted, ensure the lamp is switched off.

Turn the lamp on and off, on and off, on and off and then on again. The Lamp will then flash on and off to indicate that it is paired to your Aone hub.

Once your lamp is discovered press the “All devices have been discovered” button. You can change the name of the Lamp using the edit icon.

③ That's it!

You've finished setting up your Aurora Smart Lamp and you can now control it remotely.

Remember: To turn your Aurora Smart Lamp on or off remotely it must be switched on at the wall/fixture. Your Aurora Smart Lamp should not be dimmed using a wall mounted dimmer switch as it may cause buzzing or flickering. Use in dry locations only.

Usage

Your Aurora Smart Lamp is designed for indoor use only. Not suitable for emergency lighting.

Maintenance

Disconnect your Aurora Smart Lamp before cleaning and keep it away from water and other liquids at all times. The Aurora Smart Lamp does not contain any serviceable parts so do not attempt to open it.
